BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

GRAND CHAMPION

Champions of Record and dogs which have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed that are entered in Best of Breed competition are eligible for Grand Championship competition. Grand Championship points may be recorded for: Best of Breed or Best of Variety of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed or Best of Variety of Breed, Select Dog, and Select Bitch. Grand Championship points will be recorded according to the number of eligible dogs competing in the regular and non-regular (eligible for Best of Breed/Variety) classes of each breed or variety, as well as dogs competing in Best of Breed competition, according to the Schedule of Points established by the Board of Directors. (*AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 16, Section 6, effective 11-01-2017*)

AWARDS OF MERIT

Award of Merit Rosettes may be awarded at the discretion of the judge to 10% of the Best of Breed entry including the winners of the non-regular classes who are eligible for Best of Breed competition. The following are not eligible for an Award of Merit: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Winners Dog & Winners Bitch.

BEST PUPPY CLASS ELIGIBILITY

Best Puppy will be selected from the Puppy Class winners (6-9, 9-12) following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in a Puppy Class are eligible to compete.

BEST VETERAN CLASS ELIGIBILITY

Best Veteran will be selected from the Veteran Class winners following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in a Veteran Class are eligible to compete.

AMATEUR OWNER HANDLER CLASS ELIGIBILITY

For non-champion dogs at least 6 months of age. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. Entry is limited to exhibitors who have never been a professional handler, an AKC-approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13 of the AKC Dog Show Rules). *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to a professional handlers' organization, distributes rate cards, or otherwise advertise or represent themselves as handling dogs for pay.*

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY

All dogs entered in the Bred-By Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class for Best of Breed Competition.

VETERAN CLASS

***Veteran Dog Class *Veteran Bitch Class**

A class for dogs and a class for bitches that are:

7 years & under 10 years, 10 years and under 12 years, 12 years and under 14 years, 14 years of age or older.

***Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class."**

NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class – For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

Brood Bitch Class – For bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not be the owner of the produce. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merit of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with her produce and be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

BCCSC Breed Trophies

Specialty Challenge Trophies

The following Challenge Trophies will be offered by the Bearded Collie Club of Southern California for competition at this Specialty: For permanent possession of a Challenge Trophy it must be won (3) times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog nor at consecutive shows. The year, name of the winning dog and name of the dog's owner will be engraved on the trophy which will remain in the custody of the BCCSC until retired. It is the owner's responsibility to notify the Trophy Chairperson of the third win.

SWEEPSTAKES ~ PUPPY & VETERAN

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES ELIGIBILITY: The Sweepstakes is open to all Bearded Collies, who, on the day of the show, will be at least 6 months and under 20 months of age. Judging will be held before the Regular Classes. All dogs entered in Sweepstakes MUST BE entered in a Regular Class or for Best of Breed at this show. Entry fee is \$20.00 in addition to the Regular Entry Fee. Entry in the Sweepstakes must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as for the Regular Classes.

Write SWEEPSTAKES in the "Additional Class" space and state the AGE DIVISION.

CLASSIFICATION ~ VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

The following age division classes are offered for both Dogs and Bitches:

7 years and under 10 years ~ 10 years and under 12 years

12 years and under 14 years ~ 14 years and older

SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY: Division of Money: 35% of the total entry fee will be retained by the BCCSC to defray expenses. The remaining 65% will be distributed as follows: 15% to Best Veteran in Sweepstakes, 10% to Best Opposite Sex to the Best Veteran, 15% to Best Puppy, 10% to Best of Opposite Sex to the Best in Puppy, and the remainder shall be divided equally between the class winners.

I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient.
