**RESERVATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY MARCH 13, 2019. NO REFUNDS OR CANCELLATIONS AFTER CLOSING DATE.**

#### RESERVE ONLINE TODAY AT [WHERESMYSPACE.COM](http://WHERESMYSPACE.COM)

- Reserved parking will be at \$55.00 per night for an approximate 40' x 30' space. Over 40' long will require two spaces. Unreserved parking (cash at the gate) will be at \$60.00 for a 40' x 25' space. Unreserved spaces will be assigned at the discretion of the parking chairman. All vehicles will park facing the same direction. Rigs that are longer than the length stated on the reservation form will be parked at the rear of the parking area.
- All tag vehicles will be charged \$10.00 a day to park. Tag vehicles must fit into assigned space (not in aisle), or be moved at the discretion of the parking crew.
- All vehicles must be self-contained. No discharge of gray water or sanitary tanks on the ground or in open containers.
- Those wishing to park together must mail reservations in same envelope prior to closing date or make reservations at [WheresMySpace.com](http://WheresMySpace.com) and note who and where you want to be set up by.
- A limited number of Handicapped parking spaces are available with valid identification only.
- All parking at your own risk. San Luis Obispo Kennel Club and/or Kern County Kennel Club, Inc. assumes no responsibility or liability for damage or loss to any vehicles, its contents or dogs.
- Fire lanes must be kept open at all times. Vehicles illegally parked are subject to towing at owners expense with no prior notice.
- No generators allowed operating between 10:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M.
- Exhibitors are responsible for damage and cleanup of their parking space. Any additional cleanup charged by Fairgrounds will be billed to exhibitor assigned to that space.
- Gates will open Wednesday at 2 P.M. and close at 11 P.M. Gates will open on show days at 6 A.M. and close at 7 A.M. for those exhibitors that have reserved parking spaces. For parking Saturday, the gates will open one hour after the Best in Show judging on that day and close at 10 P.M. Prior to the opening of gates for reserved parking, vehicles must park across the street in the P Street parking lot. No vehicles may park overnight in the P Street lot.
- Parking is a privilege extended by Kern County Kennel Club which can and will be withdrawn from those who do not follow the instructions and rules of the parking crew, or who resort to abusive language and other tactics.
- No visitors will be allowed to drive their vehicles into the reserved parking areas. They must park across the street and walk in.
- Unreserved parking will be assigned and paid (cash only) at the gate, if space is available.
- All RVs must have a working fire extinguisher.
- No electrical cords to be run across paved roadways.

**ATTENTION EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS**

1. NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT IN BUILDINGS OVERNIGHT. BUILDINGS WILL BE LOCKED.
2. Cleaning up after your dogs is your responsibility. Pooper scoopers in chlorine filled buckets will be placed around the show grounds and outside all show rings. If your dog's soil the grounds it is your responsibility to clean it up. By signing the entry form for these dog shows you are agreeing that cleanup is your responsibility. Exhibitors, if you see an area that has not been cleaned up, please notify a member of the club immediately.
3. **Grooming and Set-ups.** No grooming, grooming tables or exercise pens in aisles or restricted areas. Grooming to be in designated areas only. Grooming tables, crates, and pens, which are placed in restricted areas will be removed by an authorized person.
4. **FOOD WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE ON THE GROUNDS EACH NIGHT AND DURING THE DAY.**
5. **Special Attention – no owner or agent shall allow his/her animals to be put in jeopardy of the elements; that to so so will result in damaged vehicles during rescue attempts by the event committee; at owners expense. To report a dog in distress go to our announcer located in Building 2. If the dog is in a car, license # & location are needed. This also applies to dogs being neglected on the show grounds.**

**Make All Checks and Money Orders PAYABLE TO LEA PLAUT, CANADIAN** exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Tabulate carefully. Due to cost of processing no refunds of \$5.00 and under will be made. There is a \$4.00 fee for any entry cancellations.

**A Recording Fee of 50¢ per dog and a Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry, \$3.00 Rally fee** will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, Rally Trial or Tracking Test. These Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

**No Entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

**Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

**Post Dated Checks, Returned Checks and Declined Credit Cards**, do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretaries will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. The returned check or declined credit card **MUST BE MADE GOOD** by cash or money order **BEFORE** the dog will be allowed in the ring.

**No Refund for Duplicate Entries.** This club and its Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.

**Errors on Entry Blanks.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

**During the hours of judging** owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready for judging. In order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. It is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dogs presence is needed in the judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler to bring his dog into the ring.

**The club, its secretaries or their employees** will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show grounds.

**Cash Prizes** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Secretaries Office advised at once. The Secretaries and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

**Trophies and Prizes** will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of judging, any discrepancies must be reported to the Secretary prior to completion of judging. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

**Dogs which according** to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.

**Junior Handlers** who win a third Novice Class after the closing of entries may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest Conformation judging or one half hour prior to the start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

**Please DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES.** Do not leave your dogs in unlocked cars. If any dogs are seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures where it is confined without supervision, a California Humane Officer or a Security Officer will be notified to handle the situation. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Variety competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

**STUD DOG CLASS** — Will be for Stud Dog and two of their get. Stud Dog & Get do not necessarily have to be owned by the same person. Get must be entered in a Regular or Non-Regular Class or Best of Breed Competition at this show. Award will be based on the merits of the get. The Winner is not eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. First place only will be awarded in this class.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS** — Will be for Brood Bitch and two of Produce. Brood Bitch & Produce do not necessarily have to be owned by the same person. **BRACE CLASS** — For two Chinese Crested (a unit) irrespective of sex with at least one common owner. And shown by no more than two handlers. Dogs entered in Brace must be entered in a regular or non-regular class at this show. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2" etc. Fee is \$15.00 per unit. The Winners are not eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. First Place only will be awarded in this class.

**BREEDERS CLASS** — Class for three to 5 Harriers. All dogs must have at least one breeder in common who must be present to accept the award. Each dog must be entered individually in a regular or non-regular class & list Breeder's Class in the Additional Classes on the entry form

**Junior Showmanship**

**Novice Junior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Intermediate Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Senior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Junior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Intermediate Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Senior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Master Class:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 – October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one halfhour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC go online at akc.org
